INSCRYPT 2011: The 7th China International Conference on Information Security and Cryptology will be held in Beijing from November 30th to December 3rd, 2011. Inscrypt 2011 seeks high-quality research contributions in the form of well developed papers. Topics of interest encompass research advances in ALL areas of information security, cryptology, and their applications. The conference post-proceedings will be published by Springer-Verlag in LNCS series.

AUTHOR INSTRUCTIONS: Technical papers describing original research contributions are solicited. Submissions must not be concurrently under review by a conference, journal or any other venue that has proceedings. All submissions must be written in English, and must be anonymous, with no author names, affiliations, acknowledgments, or obvious references. Such a submission should begin with a title, a short abstract, a list of key words, and its introduction should summarize the contributions of the paper at a level appropriate for a non-specialist reader.
